

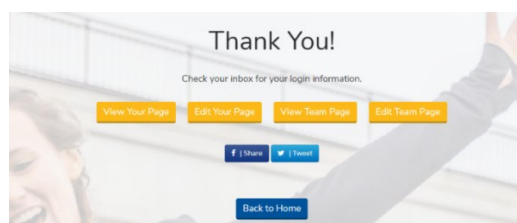
Starting a 2021 Buddy Walk Team

1. Go to 2021 Buddy Walk website: https://www.flipcause.com/secure/cause_pdetails/MTE2Nzly
2. Click on **Create or Join a Team**.




3. Sign up with Facebook or with Email.

4. To **Create a Team** you must first create an individual fundraising page and then click on *Create a Team* and Click on *Get Started*. Fill in required fields. Click *Create a Team*. Check email for more details.




5. To Join a Team you must first create an individual fundraising page and then click on *Join a Team* to join an existing team. Select Team from dropdown menu and click Join Team. Then, Click Get Started. Check your email for details.
